New PEP call for expressions of interest

Impact Evaluation Mentoring for Governments in East & West Africa

PEP is partnering with the **William and Flora Hewlett Foundation** to launch a new program, designed to develop and **strengthen high quality Impact Evaluation research capacities among governments in East and West African countries.**



Deadline for submission is **March 11, 2019**

To build and promote local expertise

The Impact Evaluation Mentoring for Governments in East and West Africa program is designed to **foster a culture of experimental evaluation, strengthen the capacity of governments to commission Impact Evaluations, and facilitate the use of evidence in policy-making.**

Selected teams will receive **practical training in Impact Evaluation** coupled with **beginning-to-end technical assistance and mentoring**, with a view to evaluating a policy initiative of their own choosing.

And analyze country-relevant policy issues

Applicant teams must present a new or existing **policy initiative that has not been evaluated in the past**, for which high quality evidence about program effectiveness is absent.

The EOI must address an issue that is **noticeably relevant to the country in terms of socioeconomic needs, political context and timing.**

Policy initiatives whose impact has not yet been evaluated in similar contexts will be favored.
