- ▶ Next Steps for Program Action



Executive Summary

- ▶ Main objective/s of the report
- ▶ Major highlights/findings on status of meeting the SDGs -identifying priority needs in the locality and best practice of the LGU in terms of program action to meet the identified need/s.
- ▶ Key sources of data



Status of Meeting the SDGs

- ▶ Presentation of available data
 - ▶ Tables, poverty maps and infographics showing processed data from LGU-CBMS database complemented with available local administrative records/data
- ▶ Data analysis
 - ▶ What does the latest data show?
 - ▶ Which barangays are faring well (worse off)? Is the situation the same across population sub-groups (by barangay, gender, age group, income class, ethnicity, others?)
 - ▶ What are the explanations for the observed trends?
- ▶ Needs identification and prioritization
- ▶ Mapping of existing local programs/initiatives aligned with achieving the SDGs



Best Practices to Achieve the SDGs

- ▶ Name of Local Program
- ▶ Key Features and Program Objective/s
- ▶ Target (Actual) Beneficiaries
- ▶ Resource Requirements
- ▶ Public-Private Partnership Collaboration



Next Steps (for Reflection/Discussion)

- ▶ Recommended possible program action for the LGU to address identified priority needs that may include (but not limited to) the following:
 - ▶ Expansion in coverage of an existing local program
 - ▶ Improvement in targeting of beneficiaries of a particular program being implemented in the locality
 - ▶ A new program/intervention that can be initiated by the LGU in partnership with key stakeholders (Private sector/CSOs)
 - ▶ Realignment in budget priorities / resource allocation
