

Conference visa (short term visitor visa) information for Senegal

Visas Required

Nationals from the following countries require a visa for entry

Visa needed **before commencing travel:**

- Bolivia
- Sri Lanka

Visa needed **upon arrival:**

- Cameroon
- Ethiopia
- Kenya
- Lesotho
- South Africa
- Tanzania
- Zambia
- Zimbabwe

Documents required for visa applications

- A passport valid for at least six (6) months after the end of your intended visit
- Photocopies of the first five (5) pages of your passport
- Fee payment: €52.50-55, payable by credit card (fees should be refunded in case of visa refusal)
- Proof of return ticket
- Proof of accommodation or hotel booking

Visa-exempt countries

Senegal is quite open to foreigners although its borders are protected by local authorities.

Nationals from these countries **DO NOT need a visa for stays up to 90 days:**

- Argentina, Benin, Burkina Faso, Canada, Congo, Ivory Coast, France, Ghana, Guinea-Bissau, Italy, Nigeria, Togo, UK.

Documents required for entry (all foreign nationals)

- A passport valid for at least six (6) months after the end of your intended visit
- At least one blank page in your passport for endorsements
- A valid visa, if required
- Sufficient funds to pay for your day-to-day expenses during your stay
- A return or onward ticket
- Yellow fever certificate, if your journey starts or passes through the yellow fever belt of Africa or South America.
