Journal Publication Grants

DATE OF LAST UPDATE: September 4th, 2025

To encourage researchers to publish their PEP research findings in formats suitable for wider dissemination, **PEP offers a USD 500 grant to the research team for the publication of a “journal article”** in any peer-reviewed journal ranking at least as **Q3** according to [Scopus \(Scimago\)](#). The journal should not be listed as a predatory journal or associated with a predatory publisher [here](#).

The acknowledgement text stated in your Research Grant Contract must appear in the journal article (and any other form of dissemination of PEP project findings) for the grant to be processed.

Disbursements will be made upon notification, by the project team leader, of the publication of an article based on a PEP-funded research project with a copy of the approved article where the inclusion of proper acknowledgement can be verified, and its exact bibliographic reference.

Note: Journal publication grants are subject to the **availability of PEP funding at the time of the request**. While PEP remains committed to supporting the dissemination of high-quality research, disbursements for journal publication may be postponed or suspended depending on current budget constraints. If publication support is not available when a claim is submitted, the project team leader will be informed accordingly.
